General Rules for Creative Arts for Home and Hobby Contests

PLEASE NOTE: WE HAVE CHANGED THE FEES STRUCTURE!

1. The Creative Arts for Home and Hobby exhibit will be held in the Richards Building on the Sussex County Fair Grounds at 37 Plains Road, Augusta, NJ.
2. **Entry Forms are available online at www.njsfcahh.com** or at the Administration Building office.
3. **TAKE NOTE:** If under 18 years old, please indicate CLEARLY on entry blank. This ensures entry will be judged within the proper age group: Teen: 13-17, Adolescent: 9-12, Child: Under 9. Also, any entries in these age groups are exempt from ANY fees. Also see Rule 12.
4. **CRAFTS (1000 category series) PRE-REGISTRATION ENTRY FEES (updated):** There is a \$5.00 entry fee PER PERSON for your first 10 entries in any canning category. There is a \$5.00 entry fee PER PERSON for each 10 entries after the first 10 entries. i.e., if you enter 10 items in the Craft Contest, you will pay \$5.00 entry fee. If you enter between 11 and 20 items in the Craft Contest, you will pay \$10.00 entry fee. **All Preregistered Entries MUST be Postmarked by July 19, 2019. Please do not mail entry forms after this date!** Address for mailing is on the entry form.

5. **BAKING (2000 category series) PRE-REGISTRATION ENTRY FEES (updated):** There is a \$5.00 entry fee PER PERSON for your first 10 entries in any baking category. There is a \$5.00 entry fee PER PERSON for each 10 entries after the first 10 entries. i.e., If you enter 10 items in the Baking Contest, you will pay \$5.00 entry fee. If you enter 12 items in the Baking Contest, you will pay \$10.00 entry fee. **All Preregistered Entries MUST be Postmarked by July 19, 2019. Please do not mail entry forms after this date!** Address for mailing is on the entry form.
[See Fee Exemptions in Rule 12 and see Rule 19 for more info]
6. **CANNING (3000 category series) PRE-REGISTRATION ENTRY FEES (updated):** There is a \$5.00 entry fee PER PERSON for your first 10 entries in any canning category. There is a \$5.00 entry fee PER PERSON for each 10 entries after the first 10 entries. i.e., If you enter 10 items in the Canning Contest, you will pay \$5.00 entry fee. If you enter between 11 and 20 items in the Canning Contest, you will pay \$10.00 entry fee. **All Preregistered Entries MUST be Postmarked by July 19, 2019. Please do not mail entry forms after this date!** Address for mailing is on the entry form.

7. **The following 5 CONTESTS are a SEPARATE \$5.00 FEE PER PERSON for each contest for pre- registered entry. (All Preregistered Entries MUST be Postmarked by July 19, 2019):**

8. **The following CONTEST is a SEPARATE FEE OF \$5.00 PER ENTRY for pre-registered entry.** No limit on the number of entries for this contest. Entry Form is under Jerky and Sausage Contest on website

9. **LATE REGISTRATION FEE: The \$5.00 fee is increased to \$7.00 for late (not pre-registered) entries. All Preregistered Entries MUST be Postmarked by July 19, 2019. Walk-in unregistered entries will be accepted the day of the contest and will pay the late registration fee of \$7.00.**
10. **TAKE-IN WEEKEND FOR CANNING, CRAFTS and BLUEBERRY (excludes Blueberry baked items) Entries to be dropped off at the Richards Building.**
CONTEST: Canning and Crafts exhibits MUST be presented at the Richards Building on:
 1. Saturday, July 27, 2019 between 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM OR
 2. Sunday, July 28, 2019 between 12:00 Noon and 5:00 PM.
 3. At one of the designated remote drop-off locations by July 19, 2019.
ONLY Blueberry Contest: Baking is due by 3:00 PM Wednesday, August 8, 2019. [See Blueberry Contest Rules]
 4. (New) If you pre-registered and change your item (craft or baking) at drop-off, there will be a \$1.00 charge to re-type the entry card.

12. **FEE EXEMPTION:**
 - Cupcake Decorating Contest for Kids - August 6, 2019- Registration Day of Contest
 - Doll and Me Look-A-Like Contest for Kids- August 6, 2019 - Pre-Registration by Mail or day of contest between 3 pm to 4 pm (1 hour before contest) in the Richards Building or 4 pm to 4:30 pm prior to the contest. Registration is Mandatory. See Flyer for category numbers.
 - Categories 3001, 3401, 3402 and 3403 are EXEMPT FROM FEE.
 - ANY entry in ANY category by a TEEN, ADOLESCENT or CHILD
13. All **entries** must be in the proper Category on the Entry Form.
14. **No exhibit will be accepted with the exhibitor's name exposed.** A piece of masking tape or painters tape (blue tape) should be used by the exhibitor to cover name if it appears. This includes the recipes for baking contests.
15. **No more than three entries are allowed by each exhibitor in any category.**
16. **PROFESSIONALS will NOT be judged with non-professionals.** One must note Professional status on the entry form for all categories.

Professional is defined as:

1. One who sells or offers for sale any item in the category.
2. Anyone who receives compensation in the form of cash or other valuable consideration for any service related to their craft. This includes teaching, demonstrating, producing samples, designing, publishing, judging, and related activities. Prizes or premiums will not be considered compensation for purposes of professional designation.
3. Once one qualifies as professional based on these rules such designation is perpetual. (e.g. if you sold a quilt in 1948, you are still a professional)
4. Professionals do not have to supply recipes of baked goods with entered items.

17. Acceptance of any entry will be at the discretion of the Committee.

18. NO EXHIBIT WILL BE REMOVED before the scheduled end of the New Jersey State Fair/ SCFHS 2018 before 6:00 PM on Sunday, August 11, 2019. Exhibits MUST be picked-up by 7:30 PM SHARP !!! All entries that remain after 7:30 PM at closing then become property of the Creative Arts for Home and Hobby Division. Only in the case of adverse conditions forcing the legal closing of the entire Fair will permit earlier returns / pickups. NO EXCEPTIONS !!

19. ALL BAKING RULES --

1. Exhibits **MUST** be presented on **disposable containers between 10:00 AM. and 11:00AM.** Thursday, August 8, 2019 to the Richards Building. **Pre-registration is HIGHLY recommended. No more than three items in one category.**
2. **Each ENTRANT will receive ONE admission ticket in the mail when pre-registering for the ENTRANT ONLY** to gain entrance to the Fairgrounds on August 8, 2019.
3. **If you DO NOT pre-register, please be prepared to pay the admission fee.**
4. **Please be prepared for family/friends to pay the entrance fee to enter the Fairgrounds** - even to help deliver the baked goods to be judged.
5. Please be prepared in advance to transport your baked goods in wagons, etc.
6. Recipes **MUST** be included in all entries. Professionals exempt.
7. Recipes:
 - i. All recipes must be on a **SINGLE** sheet of 8 1/2" X 11" paper (Un-laminated). If a second sheet is required use the back side of the paper and/or a smaller font. On the top of the recipe put the Category (Cake, Pie, Cookie, etc.) and Year of entry. The exhibit's name should **NOT** be on the recipe.
 - ii. All recipes submitted become the property of Creative Arts for Home and Hobby and we reserve the right to publish in either paper or digital format.
 - iii. Note: We have added a special category in Paper Art for "Decorative Recipe Cards" Please Do Not use them on the recipe you are submitting with your entry.

- 20. CANNING:** Canned goods must be exhibited in two [2] identical, standard sized jars with two-piece lids AND must have ring on each jar. No decorations on jars or lids will be permitted.
- a. Canned goods preserved since August of 2018 are eligible.
 - b. For definition of canning and judging methods used, see Canning Category list.
 - c. No jars with paraffin seals will be accepted.
 - d. Recipes AND processing methods must be included on entry form AND attached to one jar. Professional category exempt.
 - e. **NO MEAT, DAIRY or SEAFOOD PRODUCTS** in any submission.
 - f. Labels on canned jars require:
 1. Contents or Item Name
 2. Date

3. Processing Methods
4. **NO** Contestant Name

g. Recipes:

1. All recipes must be on a SINGLE sheet of 8 1/2" X 11" paper (Un-laminated). Use back side of paper and/or a smaller font if more than one sheet is required
2. All recipes submitted become the property of Creative Arts for Home and Hobby and we reserve the right to publish in either paper or digital format.
3. On the top of the recipe put the Category (Jams, Jellies, etc.) and the Year of entry.
4. Note: We have added a special category in Paper Art for "Decorative Recipe Cards" Please do not use them on the recipe you are submitting with your entry.

21. CRAFTS:

- a. Articles previously entered may NOT be entered again.
- b. Only articles completed within the last three [3] years will be accepted.
- c. Articles must be clean, odor-free and presentable.
- d. No article for which there is an existing category may be exhibited in Category 3400 - Miscellaneous.
- e. Four or more like items may be judged as a separate group within the Miscellaneous category.
- f. Exhibitor must have entries to be hung for exhibit, SECURELY framed AND prepared for hanging.
- g. Any Craft entry created using CNC (Computer Controlled Equip.) equipment must be labeled accordingly.

22. The Peter's Valley School of Craft will award one scholarship to one adult and one youth in Crafts (3000 series). The award will be chosen by Peter's Valley Staff. The award will consist of a Scholarship to the School of Craft. For additional information, please visit: www.petersvalley.org.

23. All entries will be accepted, arranged and displayed at the discretion of the Committee.

24. Judges' decisions are based on overall workmanship, general appearance and neatness. ALL ribbons will be awarded at the discretion of the judges.

24. All ribbon winners will be published in the New Jersey Herald at their discretion.

NEW - PRE-REGISTRATION IS MANDATORY FOR REMOTE DROP-OFF

We are providing remote drop-off locations for exhibitors who do not wish to travel to do so. This enables residents who reside a distance from the Fair to still participate in exhibiting. Claim tickets will be kept on file at the Fairgrounds for pick-up on August 11, 2019 and a driver's license is required for proper identification. **PRE-REGISTRATION FOR REMOTE DROP-OFF IS MANDATORY.** Please enclose a copy of your entry form WITH your entry and/or entries at your drop-off site and indicate if you will be picking your items up at the FAIR or at the remote drop-off site. Only items dropped off at the remote drop off sites will be able to be picked up at the remote drop off sites.
